ACADEMIC POLICY EXCEPTIONS FOR SPRING 2020

Policy Exceptions

Pass / No Credit Grade Replacement

PASS / NO CREDIT

Due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Faculty Executive Committee has voted to create an exception to the <u>UNC Charlotte grading policy</u> for Spring 2020. This change gives students the option to request Pass/No Credit grades to replace standard letter grades for any or all of their Spring 2020 courses after the completion of the semester. Students should continue to be active in classes and complete all course requirements through the remainder of the semester.

Faculty will provide letter grades for semester-long work as usual at the end of the semester. Students have the option to replace standard letter grades for their Spring 2020 courses with Pass/No Credit (for undergraduates) or Pass/Unsatisfactory (for graduate students). No Credit (N) is not an option in the graduate grading scale.

To <u>replace a grade</u>, students must use the P/N or P/U grading election option in Banner Self Service available through My UNC Charlotte. Students should not send grading petitions to their advisor.

Students who wish to replace a letter grade will need to make this election in Banner Self Service by June 1, 2020. The details of the Pass/No Credit accommodation in the Exceptions to the Grading Policy for Spring 2020 may be viewed here.
